DECEMBER PUBLIC TOURS FOCUS ON JASPER JOHNS, POP ART, PHOTOGRAPHY, AND NEW PERMANENT COLLECTION DISPLAY

The Walker Art Center's December gallery tours focus on the exhibitions *Past Things and Present: Jasper Johns since 1983*, *The Last Picture Show: Artists Using Photography, 1960-1982*, *Pop³: Oldenburg, Rosenquist, Warhol*, and *Selections from the Permanent Collection*. Visitors can also take part in a Better Looking gallery talk on Thursday, December 18, at 1 and 6 pm, that allows visitors to ask burning questions about works in the Walker's collection.
